It would also be very easy to convert the second and third floor into a 3BR, 2 full-BR luxury living quarters with its private entrance.



This is a very high-tech office. It is fully computerized (SoftDent, digital radiography, imaging). We have networked computers in each operatory, with a RAID server, online backups, and shared internet. We have totally digital x-ray systems including panoramic as well as periapical systems. We use surgical, curing and cavity detecting lasers routinely. We have been utilizing manual face-bow Occlusal Analysis systems for years and recently we bought and started to use a computer guided T-Scan Occlusal calibration systems for better and more accurate finish for our reconstructive cases. Naturally we also have all the usual dental equipment and instruments found in all the other dental offices. In our dental laboratory we have new model grinders, and lathes. In the basement we have a new air compressor and a new vacuum system.

As you can see everything is well maintained and beautiful.

The current staff is a joy to work with. They work together very well.

We practice dentistry with the patients' overall health in mind. We are very conscious of the occupational hazards resulting from exposure to heavy metals, so we try to minimize it whenever we can. Subsequently we use safety equipment no other dental office uses in central PA. It is my responsibility to keep my patients, my staff and myself as healthy as I can.
